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2022 Juried Art Show

Each year Frontier School Division hosts a Juried Art Show showcasing the artwork of division students enrolled in Grades 7 – 12 and in the Adult Education program.

The 2022 Juried Art Show is held in conjunction with the Annual School Committee Conference which takes place February 16-18, 2022 at the Canad Inn Fort Garry.

A panel of jurors will adjudicate all artwork submitted. The adjudication will take place on Tuesday, February 5th and Wednesday, February 6th, with the official opening of the show scheduled for the evening of February 6th. The jurors will award cash prizes of \$100.00 (first), \$50.00 (second), and \$25.00 (third) in each category and a written critique will be sent to each student following the show.

Delegates to the Annual School Committee Conference will vote on a “People’s Choice” award. The recipient of the “People’s Choice” award will receive \$150.00.

Students will have the opportunity to sell their artwork at the show. Refer to page 11 for details.

All work will be returned to the school following the art show.

If for some reason the Juried Art Show cannot be held in person, we may choose to create a virtual art show similar to 2021 Juried Art Show.

Exhibition at Graffiti Art Gallery

At the conclusion of the 2022 Juried Art Show, Graffiti Art Gallery will be taking a number of pieces for a four-week exhibition at their Winnipeg gallery. This is an excellent opportunity to showcase Frontier’s student talent to the public.

Final deadline for submissions is January 21, 2022.

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Categories

Submissions will be judged according to the categories listed below.

<u>Category</u>	<u>Description (including, but not limited to...)</u>
A. Drawing	Graphite pencil, Pen and ink, Pencil crayons, Wax crayons, Conte crayons, Soft pastels, Oil pastels, Chalk, Charcoal
B. Mixed Media	Mixed media (eg. photos embellished with paint), Lino cut, Printmaking, Mixing two or more of paint/ink/chalk/ pastel/ photo/string/paper/plastic etc..)
C. Painting	Acrylic, Watercolour (this includes tempera, gouache, and watercolour pencils), Permanent and water-based inks,
D. Pottery and Sculpture	Stone, Clay, Metal, Wood carving (including antler/bone), Papier-mâché, Mask, etc...
E. Crafts	Leather, Beadwork, Glasswork, Quilting, Weaving, Jewelry, Basketry, Silk screening, Wood art, Small Furniture
F. Digital Photography (8 x 10)	Straight digital photographs with <i>minimal alteration</i> [ie. adjusting brightness/contrast, colour balance, tone, etc.] printed on photographic paper (8x10). <u>Must be original works.</u>
G. Enhanced Digital Photography	Enhanced digital photographs which are <i>significantly altered</i> from the original [ie. application of filters, use of spot colour, added effects, etc.], printed on photographic paper (8x10). <u>Must be original works.</u>

H. Filmmaking

Commercials, Vignette, Newscasts, Interviews, Music

Must be submitted in MPEG or AVI format

3 - 5 minutes maximum

Must fit on DVD-R or CD-R

Include title page, credits, etc.

I. Animation

Short Film, Cartoon, Claymation

Must be submitted in MPEG or AVI format

3 - 5 minutes maximum

Must fit on DVD-R or CD-R

Include title page, credits, etc.

Rules & Eligibility

1. The art show is open to all Division amateur artists enrolled in Grades 7 to 12, & Adult Education Students.
2. Entries will be displayed and judged within the following groups:
 - 1) Grades 7 - 8
 - 2) Grades 9 - 10
 - 3) Grades 11, 12 and Adult Ed.
3. **Maximum of three (3) entries per student.**
4. All work must be original and completed between January 1, 2021 and January 21, 2022 (commercial kits or patterns are not eligible), and must not have been previously judged.
5. Multiple submission of the same artwork (i.e. themed class projects) will not be accepted. The school (students, staff, etc.) must select the best piece for submission. For example, if an entire class does paintings of autumn leaves - only one piece can be chosen for entry into the art show.
6. **All 2-D entries must be either matted, mounted (foam core is preferred) or framed, and ready for hanging** utilizing secure hardware (ie. not tape & string). All hardware must be placed at the top ↑ of the artwork. The Art Show Committee will not attach hanging hardware to the back of your frame - this is the responsibility of the artist. Work not meeting these conditions will not be accepted.
7. Instructions for hanging or display, if required, must be provided. If the artwork is abstract in design, please use arrows on the back side to indicate which side is up. If a special display is required, it must be provided by the artist.
8. a) Due to the weight limitations of the display boards, **remove glass from framed artwork and mount art on an appropriate material** (ie. no particleboard). Please use secure hangers.
b) Furniture and other heavy or bulky pieces requiring more than one person to lift or carry will not be accepted.
9. Filmmaking and Animation entries must be in either MPEG or AVI formats.
10. *****IMPORTANT ***** Two (2) entry forms must be completed. One form must be attached to the artwork for identification. The second form must be forwarded to the Fine Arts Coordinator – Shannon McIsaac. Unidentified artwork will be not entered.
11. The adjudicators reserve the right to reclassify submissions.
12. The **deadline for artwork to reach the Fine Arts Coordinator is January 21, 2022.** Late entries will not be accepted. Please note this years event is a week earlier than previously.
13. The Art Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any work that does not meet the above guidelines.

14. All artwork must remain with the Frontier School Division Juried Art Show Exhibition for the duration of the show.
15. Pictures of artwork will be posted on the Juried Art Show web site.

Use of Copyrighted Materials

In accordance with copyright law, the following guidelines must be observed if using copyrighted material such as pre-recorded music, images, literature, etc.:

- the CD/DVD is for show purposes only and **cannot** be offered for sale,
- the source of the material (i.e. artist, album, publication, etc.) must be acknowledged in the credits.

Insurance

The Frontier School Division Juried Art Exhibition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any entries and exhibits. Private insurance is your own responsibility.

Packing

Entries must be packed properly in a container suitable for shipping, which will be reused for the return of the artwork. Clearly indicate the name of the school on the outside of the container.

Shipping

Artwork can be sent to the nearest **DROP OFF DEPOT**. The deadline for the artwork to reach the Drop-off Depot is **January 14, 2022**. After the show, entries will be returned to the depot nearest the school. The depot must ensure the entries are received by the Fine Arts Coordinator **no later than January 21, 2022**.

If it is more convenient, schools can ship their artwork directly to the Fine Arts Coordinator. Entries must be received by the **January 21, 2022 deadline**.



Below are a few examples of very basic, wireless picture hanging solutions.


Please be sure to review weight restrictions before choosing hangers for art work.

Nailess Sawtooth Hangers




These work well, especially with wood.

Foamboard Sawtooth Metal Hanger




These work well.

Foamboard Kwik Metal Hanger



These are good for very light pieces or use 2 and run a wire between them.

Plastic Zig-Zag Hangers



These are great! They have an adhesive backing and are easy to use.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

The following are shipping procedures for the Juried Art Show Exhibition.

1. **Prior to shipping, ***IMPORTANT ***fax a copy of the entry form to:**

2. **Attach a copy of the entry form***IMPORTANT*** to EACH PIECE of work being submitted.** This eliminates any guesswork as to matching entry forms to the artwork. If the entry form is not attached, the article will not be accepted for the show.
3. **Please encourage artists to name their work.** Any unnamed submissions will be displayed as “Untitled” at the art show. A name can help the viewer have a better understanding of the piece.
4. Each article must be packed properly for shipping.
5. Articles can be sent to the nearest Drop-Off Depot (refer to page 8). The Drop-off Depot will then ship articles to the Entry Coordinator. Or, if practical, articles can be sent directly to the Entry Coordinator.
6. All articles must reach the Drop-off Depot by 4:00 p.m., January 14, 2022 and must be received by the Entry Coordinator no later than 4:00 p.m. January 21, 2022.

Final deadline for submissions to be received by Entry Coordinator is January 21, 2022.

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Offering Items of Work for Sale

If the artist would like to sell any of his/her entered items, please follow this procedure:

1. In the "For Sale" column on the entry form, indicate "Yes" or "No". If "Yes", indicate the sale price of the item in the "Price" column. If the "Price" column is left blank, it will be assumed the item is not for sale.
2. A receipt for sold items will be issued to the purchaser. All purchases will be paid by cheque, made payable to the student artist.
3. Sold items will be given to the purchaser at the conclusion of the Juried Art Show on Friday, February 18, 2022.
